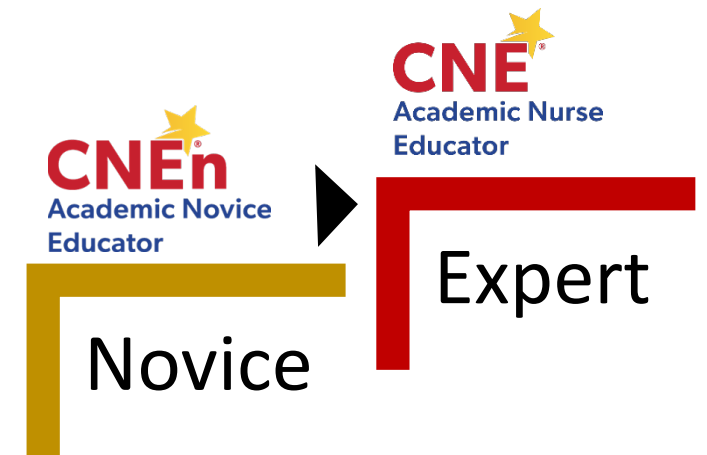
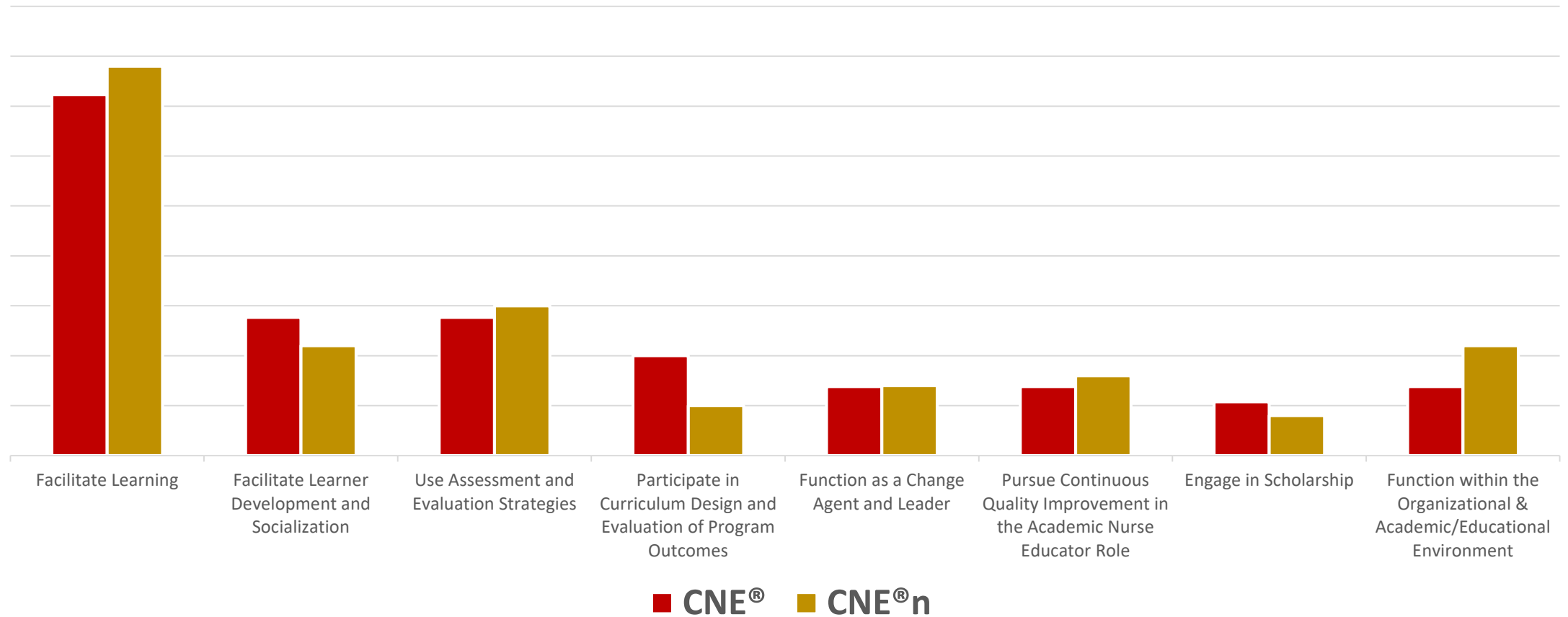


Definitions

- **CNE^{®n} = Academic Novice Educator**
 - “created as a means for novice nurse educators to validate knowledge of the role of the **novice** nurse educator”
- **CNE[®] = Academic Nurse Educator**
 - “created to establish nursing education as a specialty area of practice and create a means for faculty to demonstrate their **expertise** in this role”
- Framework: Benner’s novice-to-expert model
