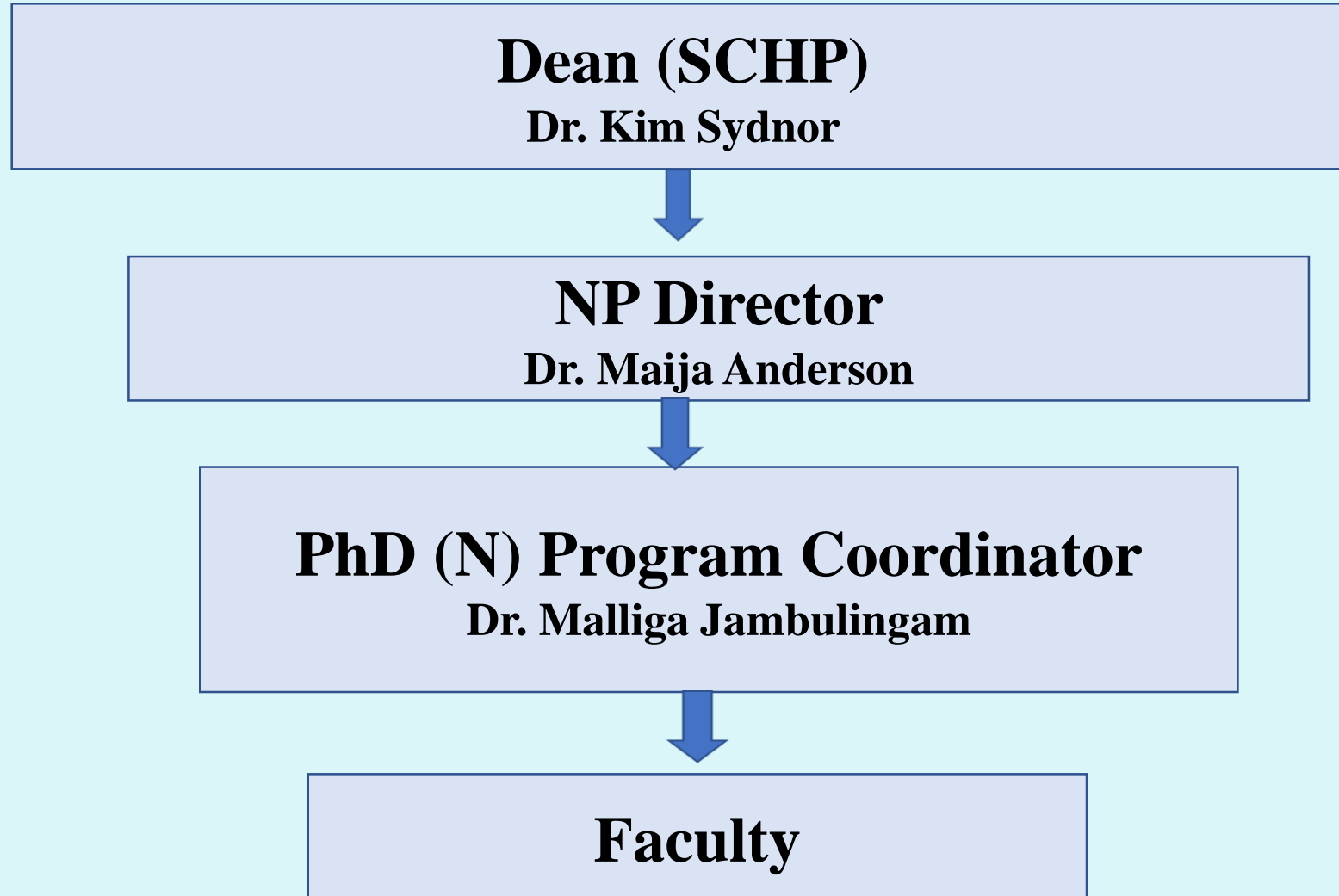

Nursing Program within the SCHP at MSU

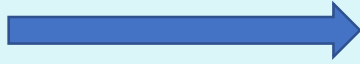
Organization Chart

- MSN from an ACEN or CCNE or MS in a health field (MASN and MPH)
- 3.0 GPA (4.0)
- If English is not your native language, TOEFL (550 paper based or 79 internet based)

PhD (N) Program

- Unrestricted active RN license
- At least 2 years of practice as a RN
- 3 letters of recommendation
- Personal academic and professional plans
- GRE – not required.

Purpose

- ❖ To prepare nurse scholars to pursue intellectual inquiry
- ❖ To conduct independent research that contributes to the body of nursing knowledge, mainly on health service and policy.
- ❖ To prepare graduates to pursue careers in research, teaching, and nursing administration

Plan of Study

- 2 years of course work with 48 credits and 1 year of dissertation
- Face to face, Weekdays (Monday through Thursday), Evening Class
- Funds: MHEC, University Funding, Sholaships
