



- 3 letters of recommendation
- Personal academic and professional plans
- GRE not required.

Purpose

- To prepare nurse scholars to pursue intellectual inquiry
- To conduct independent research that contributes to the body of nursing knowledge, mainly on health service and policy.
- To prepare graduates to pursue careers in research, teaching, and nursing administration

Plan of Study

- 2 years of course work with 48 credits and 1 year of dissertation
- Face to face, Weekdays (Monday through Thursday), Evening Class


