The University of Maryland School of Nursing (UMSON) is currently recruiting for a full-time Assistant Professor for the UMSON programs located at the Universities at Shady Gove (USG) in Rockville, Maryland.

UMSON enrolls more than 1,800 students in its baccalaureate, master's, and doctoral programs. It is ranked 6th among all schools of nursing in the nation by U.S. News & World Report, and 11th in funding for nursing schools from the National Institutes of Health. UMSON is part of the University of Maryland, graduate professional campus that also includes the schools of medicine, dentistry, law, pharmacy, and social work. Its interdisciplinary graduate school has more than 40 programs in the biosciences, law, and social work, and is one of the fastest growing biomedical research centers in the nation. The unique composition of the campus enables health professionals to address clinical care, public policy, and social issues through multidisciplinary research, scholarship, and community action. Its location in the Baltimore-Washington, D.C.-Annapolis triangle maximizes opportunities for collaboration with government agencies, health care institutions, and life science industries.

The UMSON undergraduate traditional BSN option is an upper-division, professional program providing full and part time plans of study. The traditional BSN program requires a minimum of four semesters of full-time study and all courses are offered at the USG location.
